

Key Messages

- → Today: Strong to severe thunderstorms will be possible as early as this morning, with the best chance of severe weather this afternoon and evening.
- → Saturday into Sunday: Organized severe thunderstorms appear possible late Saturday night into Sunday, though uncertainty in timing-and therefore areal extent of threat-remains.

Important Updates NEW

Timing of storms on Saturday night looks to be \rightarrow late evening into the overnight hours.





Tonight's Severe Weather Outlook

Slight Risk of Severe Storms

Overview

- Scattered storms will be possible this morning with marginally strong to severe storms.
- More widespread storms and an increased \rightarrow severe weather risk this afternoon. Large hail to the size of golf balls and 60 mph winds will be the main hazards.

Memorial Day Weekend Severe Weather Outlook


Keep up with the Forecast!

What We Know:

- A strong upper-level disturbance will move across the central U.S. on Saturday and bring the potential for organized severe weather.
- The highest chances for severe storms \rightarrow in our area is late Saturday night into Sunday.

Remaining Uncertainties:

- Exact timing will be key in determining the extent of severe weather and where the greatest severe risk will set up.
- Specific severe hazards will continue to become more clear in the coming days.
