

Strong Winds and Fire Danger

Today through Friday

Key Messages

- Red Flag Warning for localized significant fire weather conditions this morning through mid-afternoon.
- → Wind Advisory for wind gusts of 45 to 55 mph this morning through the evening.
- → Elevated to localized significant fire danger expected on Thursday and Friday.

Important Updates

→ Red Flag Warning issued (two segments) for this morning through the afternoon.

→ This afternoon, if needed.




Red Flag Warning (this morning - afternoon)







Peak Wind Gust Timing










RH and Wind Gust Thursday

Minimum Relative Humidity


Maximum Wind Gust






RH and Wind Gust Friday


